Slides	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No hanging on the slides • Slide down on your bottom only • Travel down only • One person at a time • Keep hands to self 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share and take turns • Move away quickly when done so others may have their turn • Feet first 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use only when dry • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Bars	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hang or twirl only without sitting or standing on the top • Walk around and not under • One person at a time • Get off by dropping to feet without swinging off • 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share and take turns • Move away quickly when done so others may have their turn • No bar to bar jumping 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use two hands • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Rings and Cross Bars	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hanging only without sitting or standing on top • Walk around not under • Travel in one direction • Avoid cherry drops • Get off by dropping to feet without swinging off 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share and take turns • One person at a time • Keep moving when others are waiting • Move away quickly when done so others may have their turn 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep one hand on the bars/rings • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow

Activity	Be Safe	Be Respectful	Be Responsible
Soccer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eliminate all pushing, tackling, or other rough play • Stay on feet at all times • Watch where you kick the ball • No side tackle 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow standard soccer rules • Share the ball • Include others • Play fair • Make teams fair and even in number of players 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 second throw in rule • Call your own fouls • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Kickball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Runners are put-out by tagging the runner or the base and not throwing the ball at players • Eliminate all pushing, tackling, or other rough play 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use kickball rules • Include others • Play fair • Make teams fair and even in number of players • Each player is allowed 3 pitches 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay on your base until the ball is kicked • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
4-Square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Line up outside white lines and away from play area • Use hands only, no feet 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use 4-square rules • Server must keep one foot inside box during serve • Play fair and include others 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lines are called “out” • ALL players must agree if playing by special rules • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Wall Ball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Line up outside white line and away from play area • Throw ball at wall only avoiding the roof • Be aware of your surroundings • During play don’t stand against the wall • Be aware of other players and try not to peg them 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow wall ball rules • Play fair • 10 players at a time • School wall balls only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep ball in area • Vote fairly • If out, get back in line quickly • Outside players vote for out-majority wins • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Basketball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only a safe number of players may play at any given time • Play without being rough 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow standard basketball rules • Play fair and include others • Share the ball 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Tetherball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use hands only • Hit ball carefully • Avoid hanging/swinging on ropes • Line up outside white line and away from play area • Only two players in the circle at a time 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use tetherball rules • Challengers serves first and picks direction • Hands off pole and rope • Crossing line is an out • Take turns and include others 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay on own side • Call outs • Vote fairly • Outside players vote for out-majority wins • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow
Tag/Chase	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Field only • One hand 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Line up quickly and quietly when whistle blow

<p>LEVEL 1 BEHAVIORS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disruptive behaviors Not malicious Not chronic • Will not cause injury • Example: talking during instruction 	<p>POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pulling a card • Teacher/student discussion • Change of seating • Badger Break Slip • Behavior contract • Loss of recess/Time out • Parent contact
<p>LEVEL 2 BEHAVIORS – MINOR REFERRAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Could result in unintentional harm • Are chronic (talking, disruptive) • Examples: minor insubordination and/or disrespect (back talking, eye rolling, running in hall) • Inappropriate language 	<p>POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warning • Break/Reset • Buddy Room support • Parent Contact • Minor referral resulting in loss of recess or privileges • Copy of Minor referral will be mailed to parent(s) • Behavior contract • Progressive discipline
<p>LEVEL 3 BEHAVIORS – MAJOR REFERRAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intentional harm (punching, kicking) • Illegal • Major insubordination • Profanity • Theft • Physically, emotionally, or verbally abusive acts toward others (profanity, threats, bullying, assault) 	<p>CONSEQUENCES</p> <p>Major referral resulting in one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent contact/meeting • Progressive discipline • Loss of privileges • Alternate Learning setting • In-school suspension • Out of school suspension • Expulsion <p>Consequence depends on degree of offense, age of student, and number of prior referrals.</p>
